IMPLANT POSTOPERATIVE CARE

Bleeding-

Some pink or blood-tinged in your saliva is normal. If you are bleeding (bright red blood) use the gauze given to you, damped with cool water and bite with moderate pressure for 20 to 30 minutes. Rest quietly.

Sutures-

You will have stitches. Dr. Jon Stockton will remove them at your follow up appointment. If the stitches come out please call us and we will get you in ASAP. (Follow up is about a week after implant)

Swelling-

You may have some swelling normal. Apply an ice pack if needed.

Medication/Pain-

You may have some discomfort. (most patients have no pain after implants) If any prescriptions are needed Dr. Jon will go over them with you.

Food-

Eat soft food. Chew on other side of mouth. Drink plenty of water.

Activity –

The next 48 hours you should relax and rest with no physical activity.
